SELF SERVICE PASSWORD RESET

Using any modern web browser, go to <u>www.office.com</u> and click Sign in

A pop-up window asks you to sign into your Microsoft 365 account. Enter your UCP email address then click Next.

Your UCP email address is in the following format <u>FirstName.LastName@ucpcentralpa.org</u>. If you do not know your UCP email address, consult your supervisor.

These are requirements for a valid password

- Are at least 12 characters in length
- Contain characters from at least three of the four types:
 - UPPER CASE LETTERS (A,B,C...)
 - lower case letters (a,b,c...)
 - Numeric (0,1,2,3...)
 - Non-alphanumeric (!,@,#,\$,%,^...)
- Cannot contain your username
- Is not the same as any of your past 3 passwords
